The 3rd IWA Resource Recovery Conference 2019 – Scientific Committee is looking for paper contributions that discuss global best practice, advances in fundamental science, innovative research, successful case studies as well as economic, legislative, and societal opportunities and barriers in relation to resource recovery from water.

Building upon the successful conferences in Belgium and the USA, the third Resource Recovery from Water conference will take place in the beautiful City of Venice.

This conference will play host to 300+ water professionals and practitioners from around the globe across a range of disciplines including researchers, water utilities, technology providers, policy makers, consultants as well as market segments and industries outside of the water sector that can valorize the recovered resources.

### **Procedure for submission**

Authors willing to have their papers considered for platform or poster presentation should submit a 2-page abstract. A template can be downloaded from the conference website.

All submissions should be made via the IWA's online Platform and poster presentations will be selected upon recommendations from at least 2 reviewers, based on their scientific quality, significance, novelty and relevance to the scope of the conference.

Excellent abstracts, submitted before 28 February will be considered for peer review for publication in IWA publishing and ISI indexed journals, including a special edition on Resource Recovery from water in the prestigious journal of Water Research.
